Member entry fee: \$20 for first entry, \$15 for second

Non-member entry fee: \$25 for first entry, \$20 for second

Four Honorable Mentions: Waived entry fees for a 2024 exhibition of the artist’s choice

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS and DETAILS

- Each artist may submit two (2) entries that relate to the exhibition theme. Artists are encouraged to write a short statement (approx. 100 words) about their interpretation of the theme of “art in common” to be included on the wall label.
- **Artwork that has previously been shown at MMoA will not be accepted. No AI-generated artwork will be accepted.**
- 2-D artwork **must** be framed, wired, and ready for installation; no clips or saw tooth hangers.
- No artwork, sculpture included, **may exceed 48 inches in any direction** (including frame).
- Works not meeting these requirements will not be exhibited.
- No packing material may be stored at MMoA, and no artwork may be removed for the duration of the exhibition. Pick-up dates and times shall be arranged in advance with MMoA Visitor Services for both accepted and declined artworks. There is a **late fee of \$5 per day, per piece, for artwork not picked up at the scheduled time.**
- MMoA no longer sells artwork out of the exhibition program but shall link artist’s websites or email addresses to put potential buyers in touch with artists directly. It shall be the artist’s responsibility to arrange delivery of any sold artwork. MMoA shall take no commission.
- **Submission of work(s) to this exhibition constitutes the artist’s agreement to all of the above terms.**
