Requirements and conditions:

- Artwork may be submitted by individuals or through a schoolteacher, but is strictly limited to one (1) submission per artist to guarantee enough space for all.
- Teachers are limited to a maximum of 15 pieces of student artwork. If more than one teacher per school submits artwork, it is the teachers' responsibility to ensure they do not submit more than one work by any individual. Should MMoA receive more than one work by any individual, exhibition staff will select the artwork to be displayed.
- Artwork may not exceed 48 inches in any direction. Charcoals and pastels must be sprayed with fixative, and <u>all artwork must be either framed and wired, or matted and otherwise</u> ready to hang with Command strips or similar. MMoA staff will not prepare artwork for display.
- MMoA cannot accept art requiring electricity or art that includes living plants, animals, or perishable items. All work must be stable enough to withstand a one-month exhibition.
- MMoA reserves the right to eliminate any artwork for exhibition. Submission of entry gives the exhibition sponsors and MMoA the right to reproduce images of artwork solely for promotional purposes, with all proper credit given to the artist.
- There is no entry fee for this exhibition.
